1. **In Attendance Diana, Karyn, Wally, Dennis, Ben** Absent: **Jerry and Loren**
To date, no minutes from Jerry have been received from last month's meeting to be approved.
2. **IMPOA Dumpster Days & Swap** One pickup load per property. Scheduled for 8/15-8/16 (9:00-4:00) or until dumpsters are full. Wally will pay for the dumpsters this weekend. (note...dumpsters were full by noon on Saturday and we had to close down the site. They were picked up Sunday morning and taken to Denver. Great community project sponsored by IMPOA!)
3. **Roads and Bridges Update on the Arrowhead dangerous curves** Cindy and Lou shared their information from meetings they recently attended with Road and Bridge people and Park County Commissioners. All in attendance tonight agreed that the curves needed to be made safer, and several options are being considered. IMPOA agreed to donate \$500. to Road and Bridge (with the agreement to incur no liability) to show good faith in wanting to help get this project done. Cindy and Lou will keep us updated on the status of the project.
4. **IMPOA Road Signs** IM signs about trailers being off land by Nov 1 and NO FIRES were brought. Wally will contact the Fire Department to determine when to put up the NO FIRES signs, and Dennis will put up the trailers off by Nov. 1 signs. There was also another Indian Mountain wooden entrance sign that will be installed (where?)
5. **Merchandise supply reorder** Karyn and Lee discussed this and are considering ordering fleece vests. Lee is going to get an updated catalog with the latest colors and new orders will be discussed further at a later date.
6. **LUR Compliance** Dennis continues upgrading the fencing to keep the cows out, and old barbed wire from past projects will be picked up on Saturday and put into the dumpsters. He is keeping an eye on LUR infractions in IM and will do another drive around with volunteers after Nov. 1.
7. **Fire Burn Pit** The fire burn pit is run by the Fire Station. You can access an application to use the burn pit from the IMPOA website and then fax it in to the Fire Station to get the combination to the gate. You can also pick up an application from Fire Station #5.
8. **Membership Drive** Karyn and Lee have agreed to work on this together. Glenn will send us the most recent list of property owners, and Lee will look up phone numbers on

line. Karyn and an IM volunteer, Nina, will make phone calls to encourage people to join. We will wait to make calls until after the September newsletter comes out which will include membership information.

9. Neighborhood Watch We are looking for someone to spearhead this for Indian Mountain. Karyn will write an article about it for the Sept newsletter. IMPOA has bought Neighborhood Watch signs in the past for smaller areas (cul-de-sacs, etc) in IM where neighbors have organized their own watch areas. Glenn and Wally have signs in their areas, as well as a few other areas in IM. This may be the best way to go for now, as organizing the entire IM would be daunting for any one person.

10. P.O. Box in Como Diana said that we need our own separate box from the Rec Dist and she will fill out the form to get our free mail box at the Como Post Office.
