**Diana** started the meeting off with introductions.

**Wally** provided a budget overview. We currently have 428 IMPOA members. We currently have about \$25,000 in a 24 month CD and about \$25,000 in the IMPOA checking account.

**Diana** talked about ongoing transitions within IMPOA. New activities include once/year mailings for the annual meeting and membership dues. This was a large undertaking that took 100 hours of time with over 500 pieces of membership mail. The survey regarding the fire protection plan was received very well. Overall, the transition to the new membership procedure was a great success, but took a lot of effort. It should be easier next year.

**Mark** provided an overview of membership. There are about 2000 lots in Indian Mountain. IMPOA currently has about 428 paid members. The Board is looking at new methods of paying for membership (e.g., credit card). It was decided to not create membership cards this year to save on budget costs. Your cancelled check will be your receipt.

**Fred** talked about the need for new members. The president and treasurer positions are open. If interested, you can put your name on the ballot located on the tables.

**Mark** gave a word of thanks to Diana for her efforts as president.
